

## MOOMBA NIGHT JUMP SUPERCHALLENGE

Rules for Night Competition (jump height 1.65m )

### Example of Night Competition

1 <sup>st</sup> Round (3 jumps)	Skier 1 41m	Skier 2 48m	Skier 3 52m	Skier 4 49.5m	Skier5 42m
2 <sup>nd</sup> Round (2 jumps)	Skier 2 49.6m	Skier 4 48.7m	Skier 3 51m		
3 <sup>rd</sup> round	Skier 2 51.5m	Skier 3 50m			

The competition will be conducted over 6 nights. There will be a maximum of 30 jumpers, four per night from Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March '10 to Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> March '10. The final on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> will consist of the top six qualifiers from the four previous seeded nights

### NOTE :

The best jump of the FIRST ROUND ONLY of the five nights will be the distance used to qualify a skier to the final of six skiers. FINAL MONDAY 8<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2010
