WORLD'S GREATEST FLY THE YARRA



Some of the finest exponents of distance jumping in the world have been turning on a show for the big Melbourne Moomba crowd today. Ryan Dodd from the USA has set the mark to beat with an enormous 65.5 metre leap over the Yarra, rocketing into the air behind the Correct Craft Ski Nautique. Close behind were New Zealand's Kyle Eade and the world's best, Jaret Llewellyn from Canada, on 63 metres.

Earlier, Australian superstar Karina Nowlan threw down the gauntlet to a top field of international competitors, leading the womens slalom event into the semi finals. In the mens, the surprise leader is Nick Parsons from the USA, beating out former Moomba champions Chris Parrish (USA) and Jodi Fisher (UK).

The skiing action will be on day and night all weekend, culminating in the finals of all events on Monday including the famous Night Jump.

There are plenty of amazing performances still to come and some spectacular photo, video and interview opportunities with the world's greatest water skiers and wakeboarders, in Melbourne only once a year at the Moomba Masters.
