Deena Mapple
United States of America



Is ranked No.1 in the World in overall and jump. She is ranked second in the world in the slalom event. Deena holds the World record for the longest women's jump and will be trying to wrest the Overall Title won by Karen Neville last year.

United States of America



Has been invited to star at Moomba for the first time. She is ranked No.1 in the world in this event and recently holds the Women's world slalom record.

Jeanne Adams
United States of America



This is Jeanne's first visit to Australia and first invitation to compete at the Moomba Masters. She is an excellent trick skier and is working hard on her slalom and jump in order to place well in overall at her first Moomba Masters.

Andy Mapple
United Kingdom



is a slalom specialist and is holder of the world slalom record. He won this event a few years ago at Moomba and his technique, combined with his strength and height make him almost unbeatable in this event.

Danny Budd
United Kingdom



is a strong jump skier and is hailed as the second Mike Hazelwood. Two years ago Danny competed in his first water ski tournament on the Yarra - the Junior World Championships and has been invited to compete in the jump event.

Lisa Simoneau
United States of America



Last year Lisa won the women's jump event at the Moomba Masters and will be keen to regain this title this year. On the Pro Circuit she placed 2nd in the finals in 1988. Welcome back to Moomba.

Sam Duvall
United States of America



Is one of the top skiers in the world and will be using the Moomba Masters this year to test his early form going into the US season. Sam is a proven three event skier and is spectacular to watch in the jump event.

John Battleday
United Kingdom



is an excellent trick skier and placed well at the World Titles held in Florida last year. It's a long way to come to ski on the Yarra so John will be sure to make it worth his while.

Russell Gay
United States of America



Is the US national boys champion and this is his second invitation to ski at Moomba. He is a competent three event skier and should do well in the trick event.

Richard Kjellander
Sweden

Younger brother to Mike Kjellander (who is injured), Richard is a confident three event skier and is especially strong in the slalom and trick events. He competes on the US circuit and the experience of skiing against the best in the world at Moomba will greatly assist his development.

Austria

is one of the best jump skiers in the world placing 5th at the World Titles in Florida last year. This is Franz's first visit to Moomba for quite some time and as the Yarra River is a good place to post high jump scores, he may even be taking a new Nissan home with him.
